This classroom/laboratory addition and renovations were completed for the civil engineering department. The addition of the second floor was designed as a “feather” over the existing first floor. To maintain the character of the campus at the same time, a new window wall system was introduced that was compatible with the existing. The use of Lannon stone and aluminum curtain wall as exterior materials matched existing campus tradition. Interior spaces included classrooms, design and mechanics laboratories, computer facilities, new faculty and administrative offices, and a student project center.
